#### **ORDINANCE FOR ADOPTION**

771-2016 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE UNION COUNTY DISTRICT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN TO MODIFY THE UNION COUNTY DISTRICTSOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN BY MODIFYING THE FACILITY LEASE AGREEMENT AND WASTE DISPOSAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNION COUNTY UNTILITIES AUTHORITY (UCUA) AND COVANTA UNION, LLC (COVANTA) BY EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE FACILITY LEASE AGREEMENT FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY-TWO (22) YEARS FROM DECEMBER 15, 2031 TO DECEMBER 15, 2053, RESULTING IN SUBSTANTIAL **SAVINGS** UCUA THROUGH TO THE ELIMINATION OF THE WASTE DELIVERY OBLIGATION FOR 100,000 TONS ANNUALLY FROM GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES OUTSIDE OF THE COUNTY OF UNION.

#### ORDINANCE FOR INTRODUCTION

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND "THE LAWS OF UNION COUNTY: 772-2016 **POLICIES** ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AND AND **GENERAL** LEGISLATION" BY AMENDING PART 1, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE XIV, **BUREAUS**; **DEPARTMENTS**; **DIVISIONS**; ARTICLE XVI, DEPARTMENT **OF HUMAN SERVICES**; **ARTICLE** XVII-ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES; ARTICLE XVIII, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION; CHAPTER 44, DEPARTMENT HEAD QUALIFICATIONS; CHAPTER 138, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC: DELETING CHAPTER 64, HEALTH CARE SERVICES AND ADDING CHAPTER 140, CONTRACTED OFF-DUTY EMPLOYMENT OF LAW **ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS**; AND, ADOPTING THE 2016 DEPARTMENT **PARKS AND** RECREATION, **FEES OF FOR** RECREATION FACILITIES.

# First Reading Statement

- VICE CHAIRMAN SERGIO GRANADOS: Amending Resolution Number 2014-920, (BA#50-2014) a contract awarded through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A: 11-1 et seq., to Pennetta Industrial Automation, of Jersey City, New Jersey for the Warinanco Park Ice Rink Refrigeration System Improvements, Roselle, New Jersey. This change order will reduce the original contract amount by (\$264.00) for a new contract amount not to exceed \$808,136.00. (Union County Engineering Project Number 2014-021)
- VICE CHAIRMAN SERGIO GRANADOS: Amending Resolution Number 2015-78, (BA#65-2014) a contract awarded through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A: 11-1 et seq., to Rochelle Contracting Company, Inc., of Landing, New Jersey for the Wash-Down Stations at Rahway River Park Maintenance Facility located in Clark and Warinanco Park Maintenance Facility located in Elizabeth. This change order will reduce the original contract amount by (\$11,876.72) for a new contract amount not to exceed \$165,123.28. (Union County Engineering Project Number 2012-002)

- **2016-172 CHAIRMAN BRUCE H. BERGEN:** Authorizing the County Manager to renew the Public Official Bond with the Hartford Fire Insurance Company, Hartford, CT, for Anthony Ugoaru from March 09, 2016 through March 08, 2017 in the amount of \$1,150.00.
- **2016-173 CHAIRMAN BRUCE H. BERGEN:** Authorizing the County Manager to renew the Public Official Bond with the CNA Surety Company, Sioux Falls, SD, for Charles Gillon from March 09, 2016 through March 08, 2017 in the amount of \$1,050.00.

BERGEN:** Authorizing the County Manager to renew a contract with All Covered, a division of Konica Minolta Business Solutions, Cherry Hill, NJ, through the competitive contracting process, to provide the necessary technical support for the networks, servers and computer system throughout the County of Union for the 2016 calendar year, in an amount of not to exceed \$281,580.
