

Archery Range Rules

- Union County Archery ID Card must be prominently displayed on the Archer at all times.
- Archery ID Cards are valid January 1 through December 31 of the current year and must be renewed annually.
- The range is open daily from dawn to dusk.
- Equipment permitted: longbow, re-curve and compound bow only; limit 70 lb. draw weight.
- ID Holders **must** bring **ALL** of their own equipment. Equipment includes but is not limited to: bows, arrows, and targets.
- Targets must be compatible with equipment.
- Personal equipment should be inspected by the individual or group and maintained for safe operation.
- Only target and field points are allowed on the range. No fixed or mechanical broad-heads allowed!
- No more than 6 arrows (1 end) will be shot at each relay.
- Relay time will not exceed 10 minutes.
- All shooting will be from the marked firing line only.
- Only straight in-lane shooting is permitted.
- No crossing shots, roving or clout.
- No hunting or firearms allowed.
- Arrow retrieval/search time per end shall not exceed 5 minutes.
- Union County Police reserve the right to confiscate any Archery ID card and revoke usage rights to any individual who does not comply with Archery Range rules.

At times the Archery Range may be closed at the discretion of the County of Union.

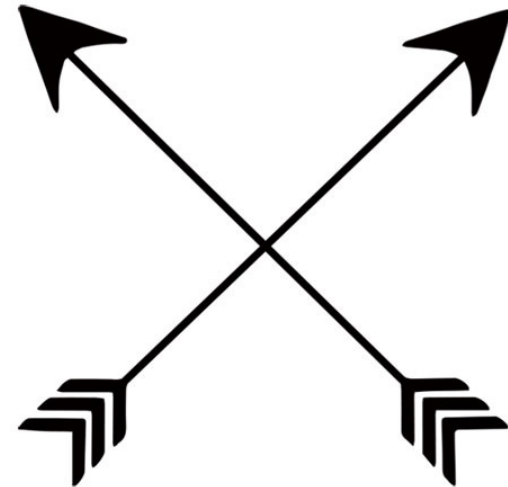

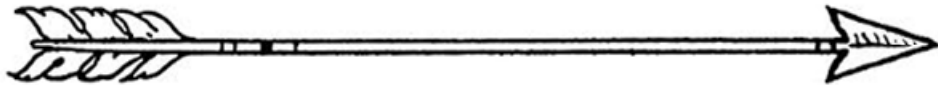

To Qualify for a Union County Archery ID Card

Archers must provide proof of having passed an archery course offered by any of the following organizations:

- National/State 4-H Shooting Sports Program
- National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP)
- National Alliance for the Development of Archery (NADA)
- National Archery Association (NAA)
- National Field Archery Association (NFAA)
- Boy/Girl Scout Archery Merit Badge Holder or Instructor
- Go Archery
- Society for Creative Anachronisms (SCA)
- International Bowmen's Organization (IBO)
- National College Athletic Association (NCAA)
- USA Archery
- Must retake safety course if ID has not been renewed after 3 years.

As of April 2014, NJ Bow Hunters License and All-Around Hunters License will not be accepted for new archery IDs.



Want to Take Your Archery Skills to the Next Level?

Archery Lessons for four (4) or fewer people are available at a rate of \$100 per person and will be scheduled at mutually agreeable times. Lessons are available by appointment only.

Participants **MUST** first have completed a **Group Archery Safety Lesson** or hold a valid **Union County Archery ID**.

How to Obtain Your Archery ID Card

After you have taken your Archery Safety Lesson, you may choose to obtain your Archery picture ID card. **This Photo ID is necessary to have in order to use the Union County Archery Range.** In addition, you must present the card signed by the Archery Instructor to receive your picture ID card. The course completion card expires within 3 months after date of class.

NEW Archery Photo ID Cards: Must be purchased **in person** at the Westfield or Elizabeth locations of the Parks Reservation Desk (see below for address).

ID Card RENEWALS: Complete a new archery ID application, available online at www.ucnj.org/archery or call a Parks Reservation Desk to have a form mailed to you. Indicate your expired ID number on the new form and mail it with your check or money order to either Union County Parks Reservation Desk address below.

Turn left on Raritan Road (the name changes to Oak Ridge Road after approximately 2 miles). Oak Ridge Park is on the right about 1/2 mile past Lake Avenue. Range is to the left.
