CITY OF PLAINFIELD (2012)

Descriptions of New Ward Boundaries January 2022

The following data resources were provided by the NJDEP Stream centerlines 2015; NJDOT Street centerlines 2015; TeleAtlas Street centerlines 2010. The parcels (2021) were provided and referenced as the interpretation made by the New Jersey Geographic Information Network (NJGIN). The municipal boundaries 2021, were provided and referenced as the interpretation made by the NJ Office of GIS. This source data was utilized for the preparation of the election district word description as stipulated under N.J.S.A. 19:4-13 et seq., as required by Administrative Law 13:17-3.1 for submission to the Office of the New Jersey Secretary of State (SOS).

The City of Plainfield in the County of Union in the State of New Jersey is comprised of a total of Four (4) Wards. Due to population changes and other concerns documented during Census 2020, new boundaries for these wards are required to meet Title 40, 40A (Municipalities, Counties) guidelines and the City's current needs. The new boundaries for these wards are described herein.

Ward One

The First Ward of the City of Plainfield shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of the West Sixth Street is intersected by the physical centerline of Central Avenue;

Thence, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Central Avenue, crossing the centerline of New Jersey Transit-Raritan Valley Line right-of-way, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of West Front Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28) and the physical centerline of Grove Street;

Continue, Northwest, following along the centerline of Grove Street, from the physical centerline of West Front Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28) to a point where said boundary intersects with the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of North Plainfield, Somerset County shared border, which is also the centerline of Green Brook (a waterway);

Thence, Northwardly, various courses, following along the centerline of the Green Brook (a waterway), which is also the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of North Plainfield, Somerset County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the City of Plainfield, Union County, Borough of North Plainfield, and the Borough of Watchung, Somerset County shared border;

Continue, Northeasterly, various courses, following along the centerline of the Green Brook (a waterway), which is also the City of Plainfield, Union County, and the Borough of Watchung, Somerset County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the City of Plainfield, Township of

Scotch Plains, Union County, and the Borough of Watchung, Somerset County shared border, which is also the physical centerline of Terrill Road (County Route 611);

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Terrill Road (County Route 611), to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of George Street, which is also the City of Plainfield and the Borough of Fanwood, Union County shared border;

Ward One (cont'd)

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of George Street, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Leland Avenue;

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Leland Avenue, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of East Fifth Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28);

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of East Fifth Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Park Avenue (County Route 531);

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Park Avenue (County Route 531), to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of West Sixth Street;

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of West Sixth Street, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Central Avenue, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Two

The Second Ward of the City of Plainfield shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Randolph Road is intersected by the physical centerline of Woodland Avenue, which is also the City of Plainfield and the Township of Scotch Plains, Union County, shared border;

Thence, West, following along the physical centerline of Randolph Road, to a point where said boundary intersects with the physical centerline of Park Avenue (County Route 531);

Thence, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Park Avenue (County Route 531), to a point where said boundary intersects with the physical centerline of East Fifth Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28);

Thence, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of East Fifth Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28), to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Leland Avenue;

Thence, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Leland Avenue, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of George Street;

Thence, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of George Street, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Terrill Road (County Route 611), which is also the City of Plainfield and the Borough of Fanwood, Union County shared border;

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Terrill Road (County Route 611), which is also the City of Plainfield and the Borough of Fanwood, Union County shared border, to its point of intersection with the City of Plainfield and the Township of Scotch Plains, Union County shared border;

Continue, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Terrill Road (County Route 611), which is also the City of Plainfield and the Township of Scotch Plains, Union County shared border, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Cushing Road;

Proceed, South, following along the extended physical centerline of Cushing Road, which is also the City of Plainfield and the Township of Scotch Plains, Union County shared border, to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Leland Avenue, which is also another point on the City of Plainfield and the Township of Scotch Plains, Union County shared border;

Thence, Southeast, following along the City of Plainfield and the Township of Scotch Plains, Union County shared border, from the physical centerline of Leland Avenue to its point of intersection with the physical centerline of Randolph Road and the physical centerline of Woodland Avenue, which is also a point on the City of Plainfield and the Township of Scotch Plains, Union County, shared border, and the point of beginning.

Ward Three

The Third Ward of the City of Plainfield shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of West Seventh Street (County Route 601) is intersected by the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of South Plainfield, Township of Piscataway, Middlesex County, shared border;

Thence, North, following along the physical centerline of West Seventh Street (County Route 601), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Lee Place;

Thence, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Lee Place, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of West Fourth Street;

Thence, North, following along the physical centerline of West Fourth Street, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Central Avenue;

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Central Avenue, to a point where said boundary intersects with the physical centerline of West Sixth Street;

Thence, Northeast, following along the physical centerline of West Sixth Street, to a point where said boundary intersects with the physical centerline of Park Avenue (County Route 531);

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Park Avenue (County Route 531), to a point where said boundary intersects with the physical centerline of Randolph Road;

Thence, West, following along the physical centerline of Randolph Road, to a point where said boundary intersects with the physical centerline of Woodland Avenue, which is also a point on the City of Plainfield and the Township of Scotch Plains, Union County, shared border;

Proceed, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Woodland Avenue, which is also the City of Plainfield and the Township of Scotch Plains, Union County, shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects with the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of South Plainfield, Middlesex County, shared border;

Thence, West, following along the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of South Plainfield, Middlesex County, shared border, from the physical centerline of Woodland Avenue to a point where said boundary intersects with the physical centerline of West Seventh Street (County Route 601), which is the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of South Plainfield, Township of Piscataway, Middlesex County, shared border, and the point of beginning.

Ward Four

The Fourth Ward of the City of Plainfield shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of the West Front Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28), which is also the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of Dunellen, Township of Piscataway, Middlesex County, shared border, is intersected by the physical centerline of Jefferson Avenue;

Thence, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Jefferson Avenue, which is the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of Dunellen, Middlesex County, shared border, from the physical centerline of West Front Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28) to a point where said boundary intersects the centerline of Green Brook (a waterway), which is also a point on the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Township of Green Brook, Somerset County shared border;

Thence, Northerly, various courses, following along the centerline of Green Brook (a waterway), which is also the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Township of Green Brook, Somerset County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Grove Street, which is also a point on the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of North Plainfield, Somerset County shared border;

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Grove Street, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Central Avenue and the physical centerline of West Front Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28);

Continue, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Central Avenue, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of West Fourth Street;

Thence, South, following along the physical centerline of West Fourth Street, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Lee Place;

Thence, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Lee Place, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of West Seventh Street (County Route 601);

Thence, South, following along the physical centerline of West Seventh Street (County Route 601), to a point where said boundary is intersected by the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of South Plainfield, Township of Piscataway, Middlesex County, shared border;

Thence, West, following along the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Township of Piscataway, Middlesex County, shared border, from the physical centerline of West Seventh Street (County Route 601) to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of the West Front Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28);

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of the West Front Street (N.J. State Highway Route 28), which is also the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Township of Piscataway, Middlesex County, shared border, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Jefferson Avenue, which is also a point on the City of Plainfield, Union County and the Borough of Dunellen, Township of Piscataway, Middlesex County, shared border and the point of beginning.

The City of Plainfield is currently located in Legislative District Twenty-Two and Congressional District Twelve.
