**CITY OF SUMMIT (2018)
Descriptions of New Ward Boundaries
January 2022**

The following data resources were provided by the NJDEP Stream centerlines 2015; NJDOT Street centerlines 2015; TeleAtlas Street centerlines 2010. The parcels (2021) were provided and referenced as the interpretation made by the New Jersey Geographic Information Network (NJGIN). The municipal boundaries 2021, were provided and referenced as the interpretation made by the NJ Office of GIS. This source data was utilized for the preparation of the election district word description as stipulated under N.J.S.A. 19:4-13 et seq., as required by Administrative Law 13:17-3.1 for submission to the Office of the New Jersey Secretary of State (SOS).

The City of Summit in the County of Union in the State of New Jersey is comprised of a total of Two (2) Wards. Due to population changes and other concerns documented during Census 2020, new boundaries for these wards are required to meet Title 40, 40A (Municipalities, Counties) and the City's current needs. The new boundaries for these wards are described herein.

Ward One

The First Ward of the City of Summit shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the City of Summit, Union County and Borough of New Providence, Union County shared border is a point on the physical centerline of Springfield Avenue (County Route 512);

Thence, Northwardly, various courses, following along the City of Summit, Union County and Borough of New Providence, Union County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the City of Summit and Township of Chatham, Union County shared border;

Continue, Northeastwardly, various courses, following along the City of Summit and Township of Chatham, Union County shared border, crossing over the physical centerline of Chatham Road (County Route 653), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Morris and Essex Turnpike (State Highway 24), which is also a point on the City of Summit, Union County and Township of Millburn, Essex County shared border;

Continue, Southeasterly, various courses, following along the physical centerline of Morris and Essex Turnpike (State Highway 24), which is also the City of Summit, Union County and Township of Millburn, Essex County shared border, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Broad Street (County Route 512);

Thence, Northwesterly, following along the physical centerline of Broad Street (County Route 512), to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Summit Avenue;

Continue, North, following along the physical centerline of Summit Avenue, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Railroad Avenue;

Thence, West, following along the physical centerline of Railroad Avenue, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Morris Avenue (County Route 651);

Ward One (cont'd)

Continue, Southeast, following along the physical centerline of Morris Avenue (County Route 651), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Springfield Avenue (County Route 512);

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Springfield Avenue (County Route 512), to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of New England Avenue;

Thence, Northwesterly, various courses, following along the physical centerline of New England Avenue, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Beekman Road;

Thence, Westwardly, following along the physical centerline of Beekman Road, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Passaic Avenue;

Continue, Southwardly, following along the physical centerline of Passaic Avenue, to another point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Springfield Avenue (County Route 512);

Thence, Southwest, following along the physical centerline of Springfield Avenue (County Route 512), to a point where said boundary intersects the City of Summit and the Borough of New Providence, Union County shared border, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Two

The Second Ward of the City of Summit shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the City of Summit, Union County and Borough of New Providence, Union County shared border is a point on the physical centerline of Springfield Avenue (County Route 512);

Continue, Eastwardly, following along the physical centerline of Springfield Avenue (County Route 512), to another point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Passaic Avenue;

Thence, North, following along the physical centerline of Passaic Avenue, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Beekman Road;

Thence, Westwardly, various courses, following along the physical centerline of Beekman Road, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of New England Avenue;

Thence, Southwardly, following along the physical centerline of New England Avenue, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Springfield Avenue (County Route 512);

Continue, East, following along the physical centerline of Springfield Avenue (County Route 512), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Morris Avenue (County Route 651);

Thence, Northwest, following along the physical centerline of Morris Avenue (County Route 651), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Railroad Avenue;

Continue, East, following along the physical centerline of Railroad Avenue, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Summit Avenue;

Thence, South, following along the physical centerline of Summit Avenue, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Broad Street (County Route 512);

Continue, Southeasterly, various courses, following along the physical centerline of Broad Street (County Route 512), to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Morris and Essex Turnpike (State Highway 24), which is also the City of Summit, Union County and Township of Millburn, Essex County shared border;

Thence, Southwesterly, various courses, following along the City of Summit, Union County and Township of Millburn, Essex County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects with a point on the City of Summit, Union County and Township of Springfield, Union County shared border;

Continue, Westwardly, various courses, following along the City of Summit, Union County and Township of Springfield, Union County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects with the City of Summit and the Borough of Mountainside, Union County shared border;

Thence, Southwesterly, following along the City of Summit and the Borough of Mountainside, Union County shared border, to its point of intersection with the City of Summit and the Borough of Berkeley Heights, Union County shared border;

Proceed, North, various courses, following along the City of Summit and the Borough of Berkeley Heights, Union County shared border, crossing the right-of-way line of Interstate 78, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Springfield Avenue (County Route 512), which is also a point on the City of Summit, Union County and Borough of New Providence, Union County shared border and also the point of beginning.


The City of Summit is currently located in Legislative District Twenty-One and Congressional District Seven.


