



# UNION COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

## REGULAR MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 29, 2022

The meeting of the Union County Board of Elections was called to order by Chair Mary Ellen Harris at 10:01am. The following were in attendance: Chair Mary Ellen Harris; Secretary / Commissioner of Registration Clara Harelik, Esq.; Commissioner James Foerst, Esq.; Commissioner Dennis Kobitz; Commissioner Raymond Szpond; Commissioner Debra Varnerin; and Administrator Nicole DiRado.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Statement of Compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act was read by Chair Harris.

Pursuant to NJSA 19:61-6 and the guidelines promulgated by the New Jersey Secretary of State, 2% of the batches created for each Congressional District were audited.

The batches include the Early Voting Machines, Election Day Voting Machines and the DS850 paper ballot tabulators. A total of 775 Batches were created.

In the 7<sup>th</sup> CD, there are a total of 358 batches; 7 audit batches were randomly selected.  
In the 8<sup>th</sup> CD, there are a total of 90 batches; 2 audit batches were randomly selected.  
In the 10<sup>th</sup> CD, there are a total of 270 batches; 5 audit batches were randomly selected.  
In the 12<sup>th</sup> CD, there are a total of 57 batches; 2 audit batches were randomly selected.
