





BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Union, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section 4.I of Ordinance No. 687-2009 entitled:

"BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY, NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLES, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, NEW ADDITIONAL FURNISHINGS, NEW COMMUNICATION AND SIGNAL SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT AND NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT IN, BY AND FOR THE COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$43,371,808 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO APPROPRIATE A STATE GRANT, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS."

adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Union, New Jersey (the "County") on July 30, 2009, as previously amended by the following five ordinances: Ordinance No. 699-2010 adopted on February 11, 2010; Ordinance No. 703-2010 adopted on May 13, 2010; Ordinance No. 714-2010 adopted on December 8, 2010; Ordinance No. 741-2012 adopted on September 13, 2012; and Ordinance No. 760-2014 adopted on October 9, 2014, is hereby amended to add the following to the projects authorized: acquisition of new furniture, carpet and window treatments for use in various public buildings; and shall hereafter read as follows:

"[Section 4.]I. Department of Engineering, Public Works and Facilities, Division of Facilities Management - The undertaking of various improvements to public buildings consisting of (i) upgrading elevators at various public buildings, (ii) replacement of roofs at various public buildings, (iii) plumbing, HVAC, pipefitting, control systems and electrical improvements at various public buildings, (iv) ADA-compliance upgrades at various public buildings, (v) upgrading mechanical systems at various public buildings, (vi) renovations to locker rooms and jail pods at the Oriscello Correctional Facility, (vii) renovations and improvements to the Elizabeth Complex Parking Garage, (viii) various improvements to the Westfield Complex, (ix) renovations to the County Correctional Facility consisting of upgrades to the Control Center (including related security and technology improvements) and elevator upgrades and (x) acquisition of new furniture, carpet and window treatments for use in various public buildings. It is hereby determined and stated that said public buildings being improved are of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law.

Period of Usefulness 15 years."

adopted by the County on August 25, 2011, as previously amended by Ordinance No. 741-2012 adopted on September 13, 2012 and Ordinance No. 760-2014 adopted on October 9, 2014, is hereby amended to add the following to the projects authorized: undertaking of the following improvements and renovations to various public buildings: asbestos abatement; interior/exterior building renovations; installation of computerized monitoring systems and door systems; electronic/electro-mechanical upgrades; emergency generator repairs and installation; installation of exhaust systems and fencing systems; lead paint remediation; mold remediation; and installation of overhead door and gate systems; and shall hereafter read as follows:

"[Section 4.]J. Department of Engineering, Public Works and Facilities, Division of Facilities Management - The undertaking of various improvements to public buildings consisting of (i) upgrading elevators at various public buildings, (ii) replacement or repair of roofs at various public buildings, (iii) plumbing, HVAC, pipefitting, control systems and electrical improvements at various public buildings, (iv) ADA-compliance upgrades at various public buildings, (v) upgrading mechanical and security systems at various public buildings, (vi) renovations to the locker rooms and pods at the Oriscello Correctional Facility and (vii) undertaking of the following improvements and renovations to various public buildings: asbestos abatement; interior/exterior building renovations; installation of computerized monitoring systems and door systems; electronic/electro-mechanical upgrades; emergency generator repairs and installation; installation of exhaust systems and fencing systems; lead paint remediation; mold remediation; and installation of overhead door and gate systems. It is hereby determined and stated that said public buildings being improved are of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

adopted by the County on September 13, 2012, as previously amended by Ordinance No. 760-2014 adopted on October 9, 2014 and Ordinance No. 786-2017 adopted on August 17, 2017, is hereby amended to add the following to the projects authorized: undertaking of the following improvements and renovations to various public buildings: ADA compliance; asbestos

abatement; building interior and exterior renovations and improvements; installation of computerized monitoring systems and door systems; electronic/electro-mechanical upgrades; elevator upgrades; emergency generator repairs and installation; installation of exhaust systems and fencing systems; lead paint remediation; installation of mechanical systems; mold remediation; installation of overhead door and gate systems; heating improvements; roof repair; and installation of security systems; and shall hereafter read as follows:

"[Section 4.]G. Department of Engineering, Public Works and Facilities, Division of Facilities Management - Undertaking of various improvements to public buildings consisting of (i) various renovations and improvements to the Union County Board of Elections Building in Elizabeth, (ii) plumbing, HVAC, pipefitting, control systems and electrical improvements at various public buildings, (iii) window replacement and other security measures at the Oriscello Correctional Facility and (iv) undertaking of the following improvements and renovations to various public buildings: ADA compliance; asbestos abatement; building interior and exterior renovations and improvements; installation of computerized monitoring systems and door systems; electronic/electro-mechanical upgrades; elevator upgrades, emergency generator repairs and installation; installation of exhaust systems and fencing systems; lead paint remediation; installation of mechanical systems; mold remediation; installation of overhead door and gate systems; heating improvements; roof repair; and installation of security systems. It is hereby determined and stated that said public buildings being improved are of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

Period of Usefulness 15 years."

Section 4. Section 4.I of Ordinance No. 740-2012 (as previously amended by Ordinance Nos. 760-2014 and 787-2017) is hereby amended to add the acquisition of new furniture, carpet and window treatments for use in various public buildings to the purposes authorized; and shall hereafter read as follows:

"[Section 4.]I. Department of Engineering, Public Works and Facilities, Division of Facilities Management - Acquisition of new additional furnishings and new automotive vehicles, including original apparatus and equipment, consisting of (i) a mason dump truck, (ii) a bucket truck and (iii) new furniture, carpet and window treatments for use in various public buildings.

adopted by the County on August 17, 2017, as amended by Ordinance No. 805-2019 adopted on February 14, 2019, is hereby amended to add the following to the projects authorized: undertaking of the following improvements and renovations to various public buildings: ADA compliance; asbestos abatement; building interior and exterior renovations and improvements; installation of computerized monitoring systems and door systems; electronic/electro-mechanical upgrades; elevator upgrades; emergency generator repairs and installation; installation of exhaust systems and fencing systems; HVAC improvements; lead paint remediation; installation of mechanical systems; mold remediation; installation of overhead door and gate systems; pipefitting and heating improvements; plumbing improvements; roof repair; and installation of security systems; and shall hereafter read as follows:

"[Section 4.]J. Department of Engineering, Public Works and Facilities Management, Division of Facilities Management - (i) Upgrading fire alarm, sprinkler and fire suppression systems in various public buildings and (ii) undertaking of the following improvements and renovations to various public buildings: ADA compliance; asbestos abatement; building interior and exterior renovations and improvements; installation of computerized monitoring systems and door systems; electronic/electro-mechanical upgrades; elevator upgrades; emergency generator repairs and installation; installation of exhaust systems and fencing systems; HVAC improvements; lead paint remediation; installation of mechanical systems; mold remediation; installation of overhead door and gate systems; pipefitting and heating improvements; plumbing improvements; roof repair; and installation of security systems.

Section 6. Section 4.P of Ordinance No. 795-2018 entitled:

"BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY, NEW ADDITIONAL FURNISHINGS, NEW COMMUNICATION AND SIGNAL SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT, NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLES, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$46,584,699 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO APPROPRIATE STATE GRANTS, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS."

adopted by the County on September 13, 2018 is hereby amended to add the following to the park and recreation improvements authorized: various improvements (including ADA improvements) to the Master Gardener Greenhouse at Watchung Reservation; and upgrading

tennis courts at various locations (including professional services); and shall hereafter read as follows:

"[Section 4.]P. Department of Parks and Recreation - Undertaking of various park and recreation improvements consisting of (i) installation of synthetic turf athletic fields (including field lighting) at various parks, (ii) construction of a handicapped-accessible fishing dock at Cedar Brook Park, (iii) replacement of the fourth ring at the Watchung Stable, (iv) preparation and design phases of the Warinanco Park Master Plan, (v) extension of Cedar Brook Park, including gazebos, walkways, landscaping and stream stabilization, (vi) various improvements (including ADA improvements) to the Master Gardener Greenhouse at Watchung Reservation and (vii) upgrading tennis courts at various locations (including professional services).

Section 7. Section 4.X of Ordinance No. 808-2019 entitled:

"BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY, NEW ADDITIONAL FURNISHINGS, NEW COMMUNICATION AND SIGNAL SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT, NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLES, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$48,560,397 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO APPROPRIATE STATE GRANTS, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS."

adopted by the County on July 25, 2019, as previously amended by Ordinance No. 825-2021

adopted on March 25, 2021, is hereby amended to (i) change one of the purposes authorized

from conversion of an existing County building for use by the Hi-Tech Task Force Unit to acquisition of various new additional or replacement equipment and machinery and new

information technology and telecommunications equipment for the use of the Hi-Tech Task

Force Unit; and (ii) decrease the period of usefulness of the purposes authorized from 15 years to

5 years (a decrease of 10 years); and shall hereafter read as follows:

"[Section 4.]X. Office of the Prosecutor - (i) Acquisition of new additional or replacement equipment and machinery consisting of firearms training simulator equipment and (ii) acquisition of various new additional or replacement equipment and machinery and new information technology and telecommunications equipment for the use of the Hi-Tech Task Force Unit.

Down Payment Appropriated \$20,200  
Bonds and Notes Authorized \$383,800  
Period of Usefulness 5 years."

Section 8. Section 11 of Ordinance No. 808-2019 (as previously amended by Ordinance No. 825-2021) is hereby amended to decrease the average period of usefulness of the purposes authorized from 12.82 years to 12.71 years (a decrease of 0.11 years), and shall hereafter read as follows:

"Section 11. It is hereby determined and declared that the average period of usefulness of said purposes, according to their reasonable lives, taking into consideration the respective amounts of bonds or notes authorized for said purposes, is a period of 12.71 years computed from the date of said bonds."

Section 9. Section 4.G of Ordinance No. 820-2020 entitled:

adopted by the County on November 5, 2020 is hereby amended to add the following to the park and recreation improvements authorized: renovation of the Warinanco Park tennis courts, including fencing and lighting improvements, conversion from clay to asphalt surface and professional services; and expansion of parking at Ponderosa Park Farm; and shall hereafter read as follows:

"[Section 4.]G. Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Park Maintenance - Undertaking of various park and recreation improvements consisting of (i) resurfacing playgrounds at various locations, (ii) installation of a new synthetic turf baseball field (including field lighting and fencing), rest room improvements and parking lot improvements (including lighting) at Mattano Park, (iii) various engineering, architectural and other services in connection with the preparation of a new Parks Master Plan, (iv) renovation of the Warinanco Park tennis courts, including fencing and lighting improvements, conversion from clay to asphalt surface and professional services, and (v) expansion of parking at Ponderosa Park Farm.

Bonds and Notes Authorized \$5,833,950  
Period of Usefulness 15 years."

Section 10. Section 4.S of Ordinance No. 834-2021 entitled:

"BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY, NEW ADDITIONAL FURNISHINGS, NEW COMMUNICATION AND SIGNAL SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT, NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLES, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$49,070,544 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO

APPROPRIATE STATE GRANTS AND COUNTY OPEN SPACE TRUST FUNDS, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS."

adopted by the County on December 2, 2021 is hereby amended to add the construction of a new parking lot on a portion of the property (including acquisition of an access easement across an existing parking lot) to the purposes authorized; and shall hereafter read as follows:

"[Section 4.]S. Department of Human Services - Acquisition of real property (containing the Union County One-Stop Career Center currently leased by the County and a parking lot) in Elizabeth for County purposes and the construction of a new parking lot on a portion of the property (including acquisition of an easement across an existing parking lot). Said property to be acquired consists of the following parcels as identified by their street address and designation on the Tax Assessment Map of Elizabeth: (i) 921-923 Elizabeth Avenue (Block 7, Lots 376 and 376 Qual.T01 (Cell Antenna)) and (ii) 5-19 North Spring Street (Block 9, Lot 1248 (part)).

Section 11. Section 4.M of Ordinance No. 839-2022 entitled:

"BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY, NEW ADDITIONAL FURNISHINGS, NEW COMMUNICATION AND SIGNAL SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT, NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLES, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$62,381,711 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO APPROPRIATE STATE GRANTS, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS."

adopted by the County on October 6, 2022 is hereby amended to add the following to the park and recreation improvements authorized: renovation of the Galloping Hill Maintenance Yard storage buildings (including professional services); installation of a driving range ball tracing system at the Galloping Hill Learning Center (including professional services); expansion of the Zimmerman Park parking lot; and hydro-raking and bio-dredging of the Briant Park Pond; and shall hereafter read as follows:

"[Section 4.]M. Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Park Maintenance - Undertaking of various park and recreation improvements consisting of (i) resurfacing and construction of tennis courts at various locations, (ii) installation of benches, tables, bike racks, water fountains, trash/recycle cans and other park amenities at various locations, (iii) improvements to walking paths at various locations, (iv) refurbishing of basketball courts (including installation of lighting) at Cedar Brook Park, (v) relocation of the basketball court at Conant Park, (vi) refurbishing of the basketball court at Sperry Park, (vii) installation of lighting at Meisel Field, (viii) construction of playgrounds at various locations, (ix) rehabilitation of the Echo Lake Pavilion, (x) installation of disc golf tee boxes at Oak Ridge Park, (xi) replacement of fitness stations at Briant Park, (xii) renovation of the Galloping Hill Maintenance Yard storage buildings (including professional services), (xiii) installation of a driving range ball tracing system at the Galloping Hill Learning Center (including professional services), (xiv)



expansion of the Zimmerman Park parking lot, and (xv) hydro-raking and bio-dredging of the Briant Park Pond.

Section 12. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners and is available for public inspection.

Section 13. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.
