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The meeting is open for the purpose of commenting on resolutions being offered for adoption and on any governmental issue that a member of the public feels may be of concern to the residents of the county.

The following resolutions are being offered for adoption:

Authorizing the County Manager to enter into a contract with Elite Vehicle Solutions through New Jersey State Contract #17-FLEET-00749 for the purchase of equipment for Union County Sheriff's transport vehicles in the amount not to exceed \$229,500.00.

Amending Resolution 2020-96 adopted January 23, 2020, a contract with Neglia Engineering Associates, Mountainside, New Jersey, to provide additional design and construction administration services related to the 2021 Road Resurfacing Project in an amount not to exceed \$38,850.00 for a new contract amount not to exceed \$323,589.00 (Union County Engineering Project Number 2019-023).

Amending Resolution 2021-77 adopted January 21, 2021, a contract with Neglia Engineering Associates, Mountainside, New Jersey, to provide additional design and construction administration services related to the 2022 Road Resurfacing Project in an amount not to exceed \$47,385.00 for a new contract amount not to exceed \$360,277.00 (Union County Engineering Project Number 2020-010).

Authorizing the County Manager to enter into an Agreement between the County of Union and the City of Summit for the installation of a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) Pedestrian Crosswalk System at the mid-block crosswalk on Morris Avenue that connects St. Teresa of Avila Church and Springfield Avenue in the City of Summit, New Jersey. System will be purchased and maintained by the City of Summit.

Concurring with the Township of Union's Resolution 2024-107, dated February 13, 2024, to install a new traffic signal on Vauxhall Road (CR 630) at the intersection of Commerce and Winslow Avenues in the Township of Union.

Authorizing the County Manager to adopt the Pre-Qualification Regulations for prospective bidders for NJDOT Funded Projects with a total construction value over \$5,000,000.00.

Authorizing the County Manager to enter into a contract with RSC Architects, Hackensack, New Jersey to provide Engineering and Consulting Services for an Elevator Replacement Project at the Union County Courthouse Complex in an amount not to exceed \$135,000.00.

Authorizing the County Manager to award the proposed contract obtained through advertising public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA40A:11-1 et seq: Department of Engineering, Public Works and Facilities Management to Traffic Safety Service, LLC for the purpose of providing Traffic Paint for a contract period of twenty-four months (24) in the amount not to exceed \$123,122.90 (BA#UCCP 11-2024).

Granting permission to the Township of Berkeley Heights (PAL) to hang a banner from April 28, 2024 to May 13, 2024 across Plainfield Avenue advertising the Berkley Heights PAL Golf Outing.

Granting permission to the Township of Berkeley Heights to hang a banner across Plainfield Avenue from August 12, 2024 to September 30, 2024 to promote Restaurant Month sponsored by the Berkeley Heights Downtown Beautification Committee.

Authorizing the Borough of Kenilworth to close the Boulevard from 24th Stree to 124th Stree (t)3 (o)1 no May 9, 2024 (f)4 (r)4 (o)1 (m)2 (7:

Granting permission to the Township of Scotch Plains to hang a banner across Park Avenue from May 1, 2024 to May 31, 2024 to celebrate "Resolve Community Counseling Center's 50th Anniversary" and to close Park Avenue from East 2nd Street to Front Street from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm on May 27, 2024 for a Memorial Day Event.

Granting permission to the Township of Scotch Plains to close Park Avenue from East 2nd Street to Front Street on October 12, 2024 from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm for a Columbus Day Event and on November 11, 2024 from 10:30 am to 12:00 pm for a Veteran's Day Event.

Granting permission to the Township of Springfield to close a portion of Mountain Avenue on May 27, 2024 from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm to hold a Memorial Day Parade.

Sponsoring WallynZavy's Autistic Kids Can Do! Autism Walk and Classic Car/Bike Fundraiser for Autism Awareness to be held on April 27, 2024, in an amount not to exceed \$500.00.

Sponsoring the Iris House, Inc., Fresh Food Market to be held on May 16, 2024, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00.

Authorizing the County Manager to award subcontracts as listed on the Union County Youth Services Commission Spending Plan to provide program services based on the Juvenile Justice Commission Points of Continuum: Prevention, Diversion, Detention, Disposition and Reentry in the total amount not to exceed \$215,797.85 for the contract period of May 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024.

Authorizing the County Manager to enter into a contract with Garden State Landscapes, Inc, Martinsville NJ through Somerset County State Approved CO-OP for Tree Removal & Trimming Services in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.00.

Authorizing the County Manager to execute a License Agreement with the City of Rahway to have its Fourth of July Fair and Fireworks display at the County's Rahway River Park on Wednesday, July 3, 2024, with a proposed rain date of Friday, July 5, 2024.

Amending Resolution 2023-472, approving the 2023-2024 Consolidated Action Plan, to increase CDBG funding utilizing contingency funds towards projects for Cerebral Palsy League and Second Street Youth Center, in an amount not to exceed \$41,500.00.

Authorizing the County Manager to execute the agreement between the Union County Workforce Development Board and the County of Union Department of Human Services for the provision of One Stop Operator (American Jobs Center Operator) of comprehensive One Stop Career Center Services.

Authorizing the County Manager to execute the agreement between the Union County Workforce Development Board and the County of Union Department of Human Services for the provision of Comprehensive One Stop Career Center Services to adults and dislocated workers.

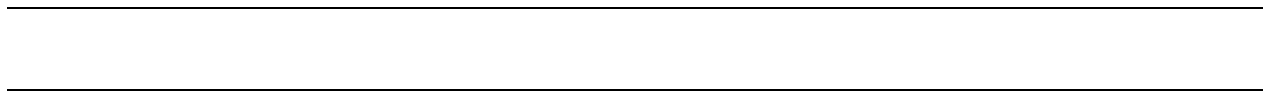
