ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

ORDINANCE Number 699-2010

An ordinance to amend a "Bond Ordinance to authorize the making of various public improvements and the acquisition of New, additional or replacement equipment and machinery, New automotive vehicles, including original apparatus and equipment, New additional furnishings, New communication and signal systems equipment and New information technology and telecommunications equipment, in by and for the County of Union, State of New Jersey, to appropriate the sum of \$43,371,808 to pay the cost thereof, to appropriate the issuance of bonds to finance such appropriation and to provide for the issuance of bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance of such bonds," adopted July 30, 2009.
