ORDINANCE FOR FIRST READING

BOND ORDINANCE No. 703-2010

An ordinance to amend section 40 of the Bond Ordinance (ord no 687-2009) Entitled "bond ordinance to authorize the making of various public improvements and the acquisition of new additional or replacement equipment and machinery, new automotive vehicles, including original apparatus and equipment, new additional furnishings, new communication and signal systems equipment and new information technology and felecommunications equipment in, by and for the County of Union, State of New Jersey, to appropriate the sum of \$43,371,808 to pay the cost thereof, to appropriate a state grant, to make a down payment, to authorize the issuance of bonds to finance such appropriation and to provide for the issuance of bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance of such bonds," adopted on July 30, 2009, as previously amended by bond ordinance no 699-2010 adopted on February 11, 2010

Freeholder Mirabella moves Ordinance Number 703-2010 for First Reading and authorizes the Clark of the Board to advertise same in accordance with the law. Public Heating and Final Reading are scheduled for Thursday, May 13, 2010
