ORDINANCE

An Ordinance amending the Administrative Code of Union County "requiring dumpsters and other refuse containers that are outdoors or exposed to stormwater to be covered at all times and prohibits the spilling, dumping, leaking, or otherwise discharge of liquids, semiliquids or solids from the containers to the municipal separate storm sewer system(s) operated by the (municipalities) and/or the waters of the State so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for the failure to comply."
