BE IT ORDAINED by the Union County Board of County Commissioners that the "Laws of Union County" are hereby amended, to be as follows (those sections not listed are unchanged):

§ 115-18. Prohibition of use of certain vehicles in County of Union parks.

A. The use of low-speed electric bicycles, motorized bicycles (a.k.a. e-bikes), low-speed electric scooters and motorized scooters, as defined herein, shall be prohibited upon any footbridge, bridle path, bicycle path, lawn, wooded area, park, playground, or any other property owned, leased, or otherwise under the control of the County of Union.


B. This prohibition shall not apply to any activity specifically authorized by N.J.S.A. 39:4-14.3(b.), on public roads and highways. All persons operating pursuant thereto shall be required to wear a helmet at all times.

C. This prohibition shall not apply to official activities of the County of Union, its employees or persons specifically authorized by the County of Union to do so.

AND, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, in case any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order or judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance, and to this end, the provisions of each section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable;

AND, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that each section of this ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law, unless otherwise indicated.
