All services are provided in a manner that preserves victim privacy and safeguards the victim's right to confidentiality (N.J.S.A. 2A:84A-22.15).

If you or someone you know has been sexually assaulted please consider taking the following steps:

Try to: get to a safe place; contact the police (911), if you are in immediate danger; reach out to the Union County Rape Crisis Center (908) 233-7273 for information/crisis services; and seek medical attention through such steps as activating your local SART Team.
Try not to: change your clothes, bathe, shower, douche, urinate, eat, drink, smoke, brush teeth, or gargle

Via the 24 hour hotline, specially trained Confidential Sexual Violence Advocates (CSVAs) provide emotional support, crisis counseling, advocacy, and in-person accompaniment through medical proceedings (i.e. sexual assault forensic examinations) as well as law enforcement interviews (i.e. filing a police report, making a statement with the police, and/or court proceedings, including but not limited to civil protective/restraining order hearings).

As of January 1st, 2023, Cover All Kids is an initiative to reach all uninsured children in New Jersey under the age of 19. It provides NJ FamilyCare coverage to all income-eligible kids in New Jersey. Cover All Kids became New Jersey law in 2021 (P.L. 2021, c.132)

- All children under the age of 19, in income-eligible families, qualify regardless of immigration status.
- Your child does not need a social security number to apply for NJ FamilyCare.

Important Updates:

Unless otherwise excused, ABAWDs are normally required to meet work requirements when receiving SNAP. Through January 2024, the work requirement will continue to be waived for ABAWD SNAP recipients.

Students were able to apply for SNAP using the expanded eligibility until June 9, 2023. Applications filed on or after June 10, 2023, must be processed using the regular eligibility for college students.

In March 2023, all households eligible for SNAP will receive a MINIMUM \$95 monthly benefit.



Eligibility:

Your household must meet certain requirements to be eligible for SNAP and receive benefits, including meeting the maximum allowable income listed below.

A SNAP household is anyone who lives and eats together.

Household Size	Max. Income
1	\$2,248
2	\$3,041
3	\$3,833
4	\$4,625

Figures Valid October 2023- September 2024

Meeting the maximum allowable income for your household size does **not** guarantee you are eligible for SNAP. You can screen for NJ SNAP in five minutes to find out if you may be eligible for food assistance, cash assistance and more.

Households that include a senior (aged 60 and older) or people with a disability may be eligible even if their gross income exceeds the amounts in the chart.

Paratransit

The Union County Paratransit System is curb-to-curb transportation service specializing in transportation for seniors (age 60+), persons with disabilities (18 years and older) and/or economically disadvantaged residents of Union County.

Paratransit will provide non-emergency transportation for the purposes of:

- Medical
- Nutrition
- Mental Health
- Shopping
- Employment
- Recreation
- Education
- Bus & Rail Service

Out of county medical trips are provided Monday & Wednesday only.

Union County is required to provide services within a five (5) mile radius of the county borders. These requests are considered an in-county trip and will be scheduled as such.

Try to make your appointments for the middle of the day when the system is least busy. Between 10 a.m and 2 p.m.

Reservations

Reservations can be made Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. by calling the scheduling office at (908) 241-8300. First time callers should call between the hours of 1 p.m to 4 p.m.

Transportation is available on a first-come-first serve basis. Five to seven days in advance notice for a scheduled trip is recommended. If schedule permits, some limited service may be available on shorter notice

Effective February 1, 2020 it is \$3 per one-way trip.

Jersey Assistance for Community Caregiving

JACC is a program that provides in-home services to seniors at risk of placement in a nursing home. JACC includes many services designed to supplement the assistance given by the individual's caretaker.

Qualified individuals may have the opportunity to hire their own family, friends, or neighbors to provide the needed care. A case manager will work closely with the individual to develop a plan of care that best meets their needs.

To qualify you must:

- Be a Union County citizen age 60+ and a U.S. citizen/qualified alien
- Require nursing home level care
- Not be financially eligible for MLTSS or other NJ Family Care
- Have resources at or below \$40,000 for individuals, \$60,000 for couples.
- Living in the community, not assisted living or residential care facility
- Not receiving Statewide Respite services, or participating in NJ Alzheimer's Adult Day services.

The Respite Care Program offers:

- Home Health Aides

To qualify you must:

- Be a Union County Resident, 18 years & older, and US Citizen/qualified alien
- Have resources at or below \$40,000 for individuals, \$60,000 for couples.
- Living in the community, not assisted living or residential care facility
- Not receiving JACC services, MLTSS, or participating in NJ Alzheimer's Adult Day.

Social 60+

Social 60+ is designed to bring the community of older adults (60 and over) in Union County together by sharing a meal at their favorite local restaurants.

- One must be 60 years of age or older, residing in Union County, with a voucher to present at the restaurant.

■ The suggested donation is \$3.00 per voucher. Donations collected help provide more meals to those in need.

■ To obtain a voucher, please call the Union County Division on Aging at (908) 527-4870.
