

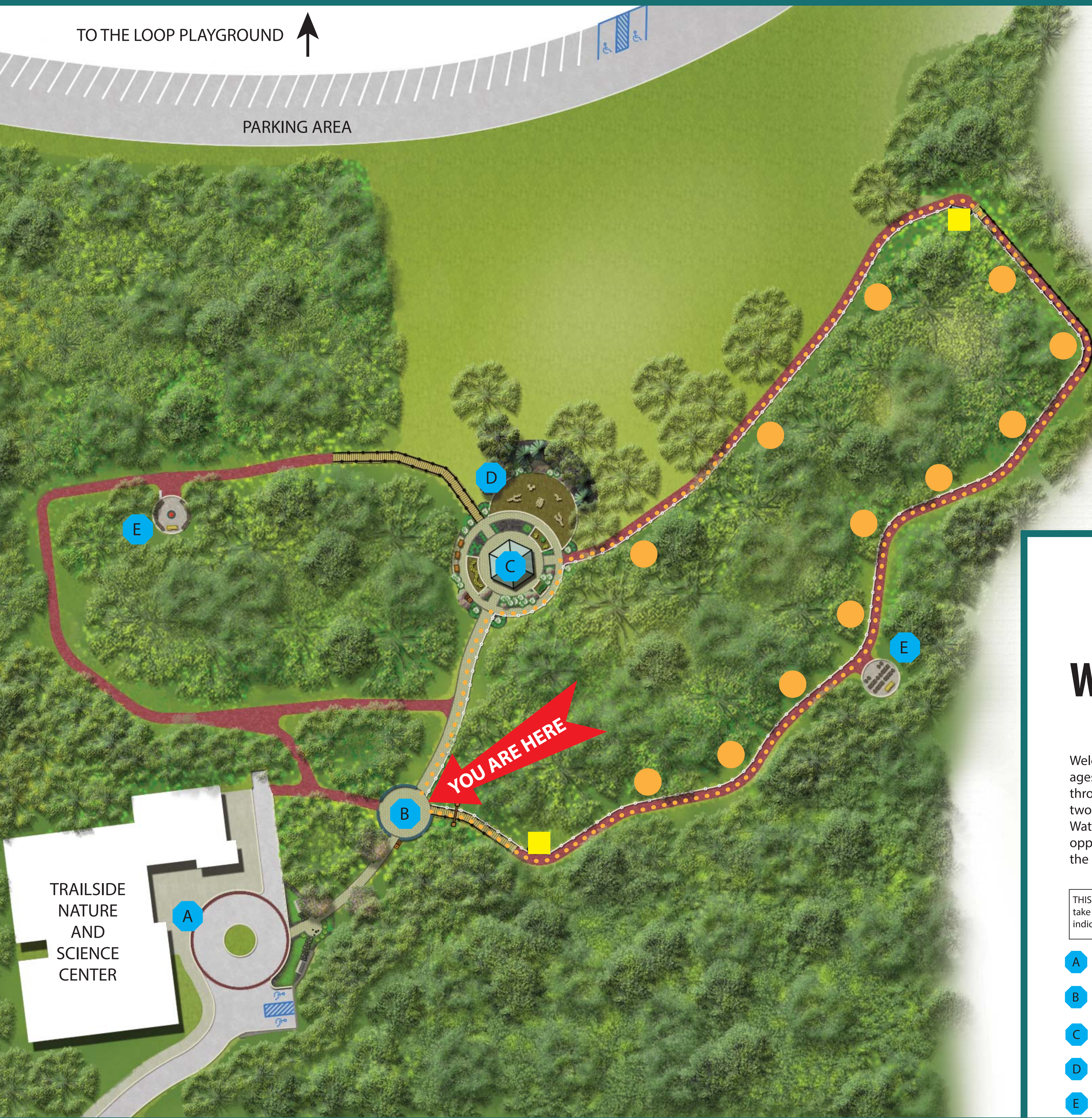

# WATCHUNG RESERVATION SENSORY TRAIL

Welcome to Union County's Sensory Friendly Trail designed for visitors of all ages and abilities. The trail loop is 0.3 miles of light to moderate terrain throughout a wooded area. There are twelve interpretive braille signs and two talking kiosks highlighting the natural and human history of the Watchung Reservation. The central gazebo area offers children the opportunity for sensory play and encourages exploration and discovery of the surrounding landscape. This trail creates an opportunity to awaken your senses and experience the natural world around you.

THIS SECTION IN BRAILLE ONLY...The braille trail loop is 0.2 mile sensory experience. To begin, please take the guide rope in your left hand and proceed along the trail to the next indicator. A sphere indicates one of twelve interpretive braille signs and a cube indicates one of two talking kiosks.
