CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Mirabella presided over the meeting and called the meeting to order at 6:35 P.M.

ROLL CALL

Roll call showed, Chairman Alexander Mirabella, Freeholder Angela R. Garretson, Freeholder Sergio Granados, Freeholder Christopher Hudak, Freeholder Bette Jane Kowalski, Freeholder Kimberly Palmieri-Mouded, Freeholder Andrea Staten, Freeholder Rebecca Williams were present; with Vice Chairman Angel G. Estrada absent.

Also present were County Manager Edward T. Oatman, County Counsel Robert E. Barry, Esq., and Clerk of the Board James E. Pellettiere.

PRAYER AND SALUTE TO THE FLAG

The prayer and salute to the flag were led by Clerk of the Board Pellettiere.

STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT

The statement of compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act was read by Clerk of the Board Pellettiere.

PRESENTATIONS BY THE BOARD

Chairman Mirabella joined by Freeholder Garretson made a presentation from the Board to retired Firefighter Gary Steitz for his years of service to the Township of Union.

Chairman Mirabella commended Firefighter Steitz for his many years of dedicated service to the Township of Union and for his efforts in keeping the community safe. He thanked Firefighter Steitz for all his hard work and wished him well on his retirement.

Firefighter Gary Steitz thanked the Board and the County as a whole for their continued support over the years.

Chairman Mirabella joined by Freeholder Hudak made a resolution presentation from the Board to retired Business Administrator Ronald Manzella for his many years of service to the Township of Union.

Chairman Mirabella offered details relative to Ronald Manzella's distinguished career, including having served in various capacities in Essex County earlier in his career and more recently as Township Administrator of Union. Chairman Mirabella recognized Mr. Manzella's wealth of knowledge and expertise, noting him as a valuable resource and employee. He thanked Mr. Manzella for his many years of service and wished him well on his retirement.

Business Administrator Ronald Manzella thanked the Board for the recognition. Director Graziano presented resident Bruce Paterson, of Garwood, with a perforated Union County Election Calendar from the County Clerk's Office.

Amending Resolution Number 2019-156, adopted February 2, 2019, (BA# 2-2019) a contract awarded through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJ.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., to Colonnelli Brothers of Hackensack, New Jersey, approving Change Order Number 1 (final) for the Replacement of Mountain Avenue Minor Bridge, Be26, Township of Berkeley Heights, New Jersey. This change order will increase the original contract amount by an amount not to exceed \$78,313.89 for a new contract amount not to exceed \$695,434.89. (Union County Engineering Project Number 2013-024) (Chairman Alexander Mirabella)
- 2. Freeholder Kowalski asked Director Graziano to elaborate on this initiative, particularly as it relates to flooding.

Director Graziano confirmed that this initiative would assist in flood-related matters as well as assist in addressing dams, lakes, and other localized flood areas. He added that certain issues at Galloping Hill Golf Course would also be addressed.

- 4. Amending Resolution Number 2018-947, adopted November 8, 2018, (BA# 31-2018) a contract awarded through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJ.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., to J.C. Freeholder Hudak asked Director Graziano to elaborate on the benefits of the cited recycling grant and inquired about how many municipalities were employing the services, noting the importance of this type of initiative.

Director Graziano advised that this particular grant varied annually and would cover costs relative to recycling advertising and events throughout the county as well as education forums and the Recycle Coach app. He added that all the municipalities employed the Recycle Coach app, noting Union County as the first to include the app on all municipal websites.

Director Anderson advised that this item related to the grant funding used for an organizational assessment conducted on the Division of Social Services by the cited vendor as a means to revamp and improve protocol within the department as well as increase community outreach.

Freeholder Williams inquired about the concluding reports of the noted assessment.

Director Anderson advised that Janus Solutions was contracted to do two separate assessments, one for Social Services and the other for the county-at-large. She added that the first report would be presented to the Board during the February 20th meeting and subsequently released to the public on February 26th at Kean University.

Director Moran noted that he was excited about this item as it was the first time the Office of Health Management would be signing an agreement to provide local health services. He added that he expected this initiative to result in \$18,000 of savings, annually for Berkeley Heights. He noted that Health Officer Annie McNair was instrumental in facilitating this initiative.

Freeholder Hudak asked Director Moran to elaborate on the nature of services being provided.

Director Moran noted that the municipality would have access to the County's Certified Health Officer as well as 4 other members of staff that were certified to assist in conducting local health inspections for various establishments, including swimming pools and restaurants, as well as assist in the review of school inoculation records to ensure compliance.
