

CITIZEN COMPLAINT INFORMATION SHEET

The Union County Prosecutor's Office is committed to providing law enforcement services that are fair, effective, and impartially applied. It is in the best interest of everyone that your complaint about the performance of an individual Detective is resolved fairly and promptly. The Office has formal procedures for investigating your complaint. These procedures ensure fairness and protect the rights of both citizens and Detectives.

1. Your complaint will be sent to a superior officer or specifically trained internal affairs officer who will conduct a thorough and objective investigation.
2. You might be asked to help in the investigation by giving a detailed statement about what happened or providing other important information.
3. All complaints against Detectives are thoroughly investigated. You will be advised in writing of the outcome of the investigation.
4. If our investigation results in a Detective being charged with a violation of Office rules, you might be asked to testify in an Office hearing.
5. If our investigation shows that the complaint is unfounded or that the Detective acted properly, the matter will be closed.
6. All disciplinary hearings shall be closed to the public unless the Detective requests an open hearing.

It is unlawful to provide information in this matter which you do not believe to be true.
