
SHOULDER PAVEMENT



CROSS SECTION STANDARD HEIGHT CURB




CROSS SECTION DEPRESSED CURB



AT DRIVEWAYS Concrete to be class "B" air entrained. Vertical joints every 10'-0' with the fiber joint filler every

All quarry process stones back fill must be placed and compacted in 6 inch layers. A temporary 2" bituminous top shall be placed and rolled.

Approximately 1 month later, the temporary patch and stone must be removed to subgrade for permanent restoration. If existing pavement thickness is less than 8", a 6" thickness of bituminous stabilized base course (Mix I-2) and 2" FABC-1 top (Mix I-5) will be placed. If existing pavement thickness is greater than 8". Thickness of stabilized based will be increased so the depth of permeant restoration is the same as existing pavement. During the winter season, the pavement restoration will be deferred until April 1st, or as soon thereafter as favorable weather permits; however, the temporary patch must be maintained.

The existing pavement abutting the trench shall be 12" beyond the edge of the trench on all sides to permit pavement edges to bear on undisturbed existing subbase.

The trench in vehicular traffic lanes must be backfilled every night. Plates over trenches are not permitted, unless specific approval is granted by the Union County Bureau of Inspections. Plates must be raped and pinned.

The applicant is responsible for the opening, protection of the opening, maintenance of the temporary and final pavement of the satisfaction of the County.

The County may perform any work necessary for the safety of the traveling public and deduct the cost of the work from the cash bond, or send additional billing to the permittee to cover the cost.

One year after final restoration, the County will re-inspect the site, and the cash bond will be returned to the permittee, if restoration is satisfactory.

All bar-holes must be filled within 24 hours, or a permit will be required. Traffic plans must be submitted with the permit when the traffic will be affected by the excavation.

Permits must be obtained from the Union County Shade Tree Bureau if any trees are to be disturbed in the County right-of-way during this excavation, call 908-789-3658.

Call 1-800-272-1000 72 hours before any digging. All work must be conforming to construction standards of jurisdiction. A copy of the ordnance for the standards and requirements must be accompanied with this permit.

All restoration must confirm to the requirements within this permit. You should also have a copy of the ordinance outlining the County policy and procedures pertaining to the requirements of this excavation work. This application must be made before any work is started except in cases of emergency. The original permit approved and signed must be available on the site at all times when work is in progress.

The permittee agrees to comply with the current laws of the State of New Jersey and the County Regulations. The acceptance of this permit shall be deemed an agreement to abide by all of its terms, conditions and requirements as set by the County of Union.

Notice must be given 24 hours before work stars to the County of Union to allow the inspectors sufficient time to check forming and compliance to standards. Call 908 789-3658 and leave a detailed message. No digging from December 1st to April 1st. All certificates of inspections naming the County as the additional insured is required.
