Authorizing the County Manager through the Union County Prosecutor's Office to apply for and accept funding from the State of New Jersey Police Training Commission for the 2014 Law Enforcement Officers Training and Equipment Grant, Part 2 for the period of November 1, 2013 through February 28, 2014 in the amount of \$8,344. **(Chairman Christopher Hudak)**
2. Authorizing the County Manager through the Office of the Union County Prosecutor's Office to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with Trinitas Hospital, Elizabeth, New Jersey to provide individual therapy sessions to victims of sexual assault for the period of January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 (Grant Funded). **(Chairman Christopher Hudak)**
