### CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Bruce Bergen presided and called the meeting to order at 7:03pm.

### ROLL CALL

Roll call showed Chairman Bruce H. Bergen, Freeholder Angel G. Estrada, Freeholder Christopher Hudak, Freeholder Mohamed S. Jalloh, Freeholder Bette Jane Kowalski, Freeholder Alexander Mirabella and Freeholder Vernell Wright were in attendance, with Freeholder Linda Carter and Vice Chairman Sergio Granados absent.

Also present were County Manager Alfred Faella, County Counsel Robert E. Barry, Esq. and Clerk of the Board James Pellettiere.

### OFFICE OF THE UNION COUNTY CLERK

### Joanne Rajoppi, County Clerk

County Clerk Rajoppi provided the Board with an overview for each of her six resolutions.

- 1. Approving the 2017 Union County Clerk Five Year Plan. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)
- 2. Authorizing the County Manager to enter into an agreement with IBM, Piscataway, New Jersey for the purpose of providing hardware and software maintenance for the Union County Clerk's imaging and web servers in both the Elizabeth and Westfield locations for the January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 contract period in an amount not to exceed \$40,736.95. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)
- 3. Authorizing the County Manager to enter into an agreement with Wisolmerski Associates, Inc., Boca Raton, Florida, for the purpose of providing technical support to the recording, indexing and accounting systems of the Office of the County Clerk for the contract period

January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 in an amount not to exceed \$41,350.00. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)

- 4. Authorizing the County Clerk to make any and all purchases of goods and/or services required in the process of preparing and conducting an election to be provided by various vendors and to provide miscellaneous election services which might arise, in an amount not to exceed \$35,000 for the 2017 elections. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)
- 5. Amending Resolution 2015-974, a contract with Full Service Mailers, Hackensack, New Jersey to increase the contract in the amount of \$23,132 for the 2017 election cycle to account for an overwhelming increase in voter registration in 2016 and an anticipated increase in 2017 for a new contract amount of \$173,517.96 for the Contract Term February 1, 2016 through January 31, 2018. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)
- 6. Authorizing the County Manager to enter into an agreement with Intersection, Secaucus, New Jersey for the purpose of providing design and advertising space for the Union County Votes App at NJ Transit train stations in advance of the 2017 Gubernatorial Campaign in an amount not to exceed \$20,000. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)

Freeholder Mirabella commented on the application.

County Clerk Rajoppi stated that approximately 2,500 people downloaded the application within the four months preceding the election.

- 2. Authorizing the County Manager, through the Union County Prosecutor's Office, to purchase computer servers from Spincube Inc. Of Jersey City, New Jersey by utilizing the pricing of NJ State Contract #40121 in an amount not to exceed \$65,000. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)
- 3. To apply for and accept funding from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant, Megan's Law, and Local Law Enforcement Grant in the amount of \$13,819 for the period of January 1, 2017 through September 30, 2017. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)

### Ronald Zuber, Director

1. Authorizing the County Manager to conduct the 2017 Deer Management Program for Union County, relative to the reduction of the white-tailed deer population within the Watchung Reservation, Nomehegan Park, Lenape Park, Summit portion of Passaic River Park, Ash Brook Reservation, the Hawk Rise Sanctuary and Plainfield (To Be Determined), during the permit season of January 7, 2017 through February 11, 2017 in the manner prescribed by the Fish and Game Code of the State of New Jersey and the 2017 Deer Management Program for Union County Guidelines in an amount not to exceed \$5,370.70. The County Manager is authorized to restrict areas when conditions necessitate. (Vice Chairman Sergio Granados)

Freeholder Mirabella asked if the department has expanded the number of locations and/or timeframe this year.

Director Zuber advised that the County will continue working within the timeframe allowed by the State. He advised that the County is adding Plainfield as a location, noting that two years ago the County added the Hawk Rise area. He added that they are considering adding Hillside in the future.

Freeholder Mirabella stared that he has received a considerable amount more of discussion from residents concerning the high population of deer in their neighborhoods; spanning many communities throughout the County.

Freeholder Estrada stated that he was the individual that reached out to the Parks Department relative to the deer population concerns in Hillside. He noted that he has received more calls on this issue of late. He advised that he would like to see this concern addressed with in the very near future.
