## STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT

The statement of compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act was read by the Clerk of the Board.

#### PRESENTATIONS FROM THE BOARD

 A Resolution presentation was made to the Union County Vocational Technical School for finishing second nationally in Relay for Life fundraising, with a total of \$180,000 being raised for the American Cancer Society. Deidre McGuiness from the American Cancer Society also joined the presentation.

Chairman Mirabella and Freeholder Scanlon called upon Superintendant of the Union County Vocational and Technical Schools Dr. Thomas Bistocchi and the students who participated in Relay for Life fundraising event for the American Cancer Society. Chairman Mirabella stated that he is proud of the students and they exceeded their goal of \$150,000. They raised in excess of \$180,000. Their goal for this year is \$195,000.

Dr. Bistocchi mentioned that they have participated in the Relay for Life for six years and mentioned that they placed second in the nation, and was the highest raising school for their size.

Chairman Mirabella asked Deidre McGuiness, Senior Director of Special Events with the American Cancer Society to speak. She stated that the Union County raised over \$1,000,000 within the last five years.

Chairman Mirabella stated that he was at Union County Vocational-Technical Schools today and thanked Dr. Bistocchi and the students for all their hard work for the American Cancer Society. He presented Dr. Bistocchi with a Resolution.

2. A Resolution presentation was made to Mr. William Tomko, a veteran of the United States Navy, celebrating his receipt of the French Medal of Honor for his service in World War II.

## CHAPTER 2, -\( 107-ARTICLE IV - FEES FOR RECREATION FACILITIES

The Director of the Department of Parks and Community Renewal is hereby authorized to set fees and one time charges not specifically included in the fee schedule. The Director of the Department of Parks and Community Renewal is hereby further authorized to amend or modify any fee set forth in the fee schedule for special promotions and events. In the event that the Director shall asses, amend or modify any fee he shall file a notice of said assessment, amendment or modification with the Clerk of the Board and the Director of the Department of Finance, no less than five days prior to the effective date of the assessment, amendment or modification.

## **PUBLIC COMMENT PORTION**

This meeting is open to the public for the purpose of commenting on any matter.

George Katikaritis, Elizabeth, urged the Board to support gay marriages. Chairman Mirabella said it is a State issue, not a County issue. He said if there is a referendum on the ballot, he will be happy to vote in favor of it.

Rich Madden, Summit City Council President, stated that he was pleased with Chairman Mirabella's Message of his initiatives for this upcoming year. He congratulated the newly elected Freeholders.

Mr. Madden addressed the high taxes for the residents of the City of Summit, and asked the Board for assistance.

Dave Bomgaars, Council of the City of Summit and Chairman of the Finance Committee for the School Board of Estimate stated that the Mayor of Summit selects the School Board of Education. He urged the Board to develop a budget to be as flat as possible. He spoke about the City's tax increases. He said that they are in favor of shared services. He thanked the Board for Resolutions 2012-101 and 2012-105, adding that the Broad Street Corridor is a tremendous project, and he is pleased with the outcome.

Tom Getzendanner, City of Summit Council Member, asked the Board to declare a Fiscal emergency. He urged the Board to privatize Runnells Specialized Hospital and to eliminate MusicFest. He gave three suggestions that should be included the budget proposal, which are attached.

Dr. Robert Rubino, Summit, urged the Board to keep Summit's tax rate flat.

Bruce Paterson, Garwood, mentioned that there was an article in the Start Ledger that taxes have increased \$1,732 per household in Union County. He urged the Board to lower taxes.

Mr. Paterson commented on County calendars and the NJ Chamber of Commerce Train Ride to Washington. He asked which Freeholders attended and stated that a report of the conference should be provided.

Chairman Mirabella stated that Freeholders Hudak, Jalloh and Sullivan participated in the NJ Chamber of Commerce Train Ride to Washington.

Salaam Ismial, National Director of the United Youth Council, Inc. stated that he submitted a letter to the Board for a Resolution to be placed on the Agenda regarding anti-violence. He stated that the cities affected by gang violence are Elizabeth, Roselle, Linden and Plainfield. He urged the Board to pass a Resolution declaring violence a public health crisis.

Chairman Mirabella thanked him for his advocacy and involvement. He said he will ask the Clerk of the Board to draft an appropriate Resolution for his approval.

Tina Renna, Cranford, commended the Council members of the City of Summit for attending the Freeholder Meeting. She stated that there should be a representative from each municipality at each Freeholder Meeting.

Mrs. Renna questioned the position controls for employees that occurred in the months of December and January which consist of a substantial amount of salary increases. She added that she could assume that County employees will not be affected by the layoffs.

Mrs. Renna spoke about the Union County Alliance. She asked for the cost of the NJ Chamber of Commerce Train Ride and commented on the League of Municipalities that occurred in November. She also commented on the Travisano v. Union County law suit.

Mrs. Renna stated that she received a note on County letterhead along with a generous donation made payable to the Union County Watchdog Association.

John Bury, Kenilworth, had questions regarding the Budget. He asked if the Executive Budget will be released soon. He asked if MusicFest will be held this year since there is no mention of This is it!

Productions on the Agenda. He also asked if County employees will be laid-off.

Mr. Bury asked if the Bond Anticipation Notes in 2010 included items for the past 10 years, such as \$1.8 million for improvements made to Oakwood Plaza, which, he added the County does not own.

Director Taylor explained that County employees are self-insured for unemployment insurance. The monies are deducted from their pay. It is payable out of the trust account.

Director Taylor explained that the Bond Anticipation Notes are for a lease agreement. Oakwood Plaza was undertaken by the Union County Improvement Authority, and the County guarantees the bond.

County Manager Faella stated that the Executive Budget will be presented within the next four to five weeks.

Chairman Mirabella stated that no decisions have been made about MusicFest to this point, but if it does happen, it will be scaled down dramatically. He said as far as layoffs of County employees, they will be under consideration when the budget is discussed.

#### FREEHOLDER REPORTS AND COMMENTS

Freeholder Kowalski thanked Nicole DiRado for her years of service as the Clerk of the Board. She complimented her work, and said that she will be missed.

Freeholder Kowalski spoke about the 150th Anniversary of the Civil War. She stated that the celebration will be held on February 9th. Opening on February 9, and continuing for the next four years, Union County Clerk Joanne Rajoppi has organized an exhibit to commemorate the 150th Anniversary of the Civil War, at the Union County Courthouse in Elizabeth. As Chair of the Union County Civil War Sesquicentennial Committee, Ms. Rajoppi has assembled a fascinating collection that provides a unique glimpse into life on the home front as well as battlefield experiences.

On behalf of the Freeholder Board, Freeholder Kowalski thanked Ms. Rajoppi and all of the Committee members for their outstanding work and dedication to historic preservation in Union County. She stated that the opening ceremony is open to the public and if you would like to attend please call the County Clerk's office at 908-527-4787 to reserve a seat.

Freeholder Scanlon thanked Nicole DiRado for her work as Clerk of the Board, and wished her well in her new position as Deputy County Clerk.

Freeholder Scanlon spoke about the 11 problematic trees that were removed from Ponderosa Park, but were replaced with 236 trees. She commended Administrator of the Open Space, Recreation and Historic Preservation Trust Fund Vikki Durbin-Drake on a job well done.

Freeholder Scanlon stated that this is the time of year when we take survey of the homeless residents of Union County, which as you may know includes hundreds of children as well as adults. This survey is a call to action, in that regard I am pleased to report that the federal government has awarded a grant of \$3.4 million to help us strengthen our commitment to lend a helping hand to those in need. She stated that part of the funds will be used for services such as job training, mental health counseling, substance abuse treatment and child care, which can help set more Union County residents on a path to permanent independence. This was a competitive grant, which was awarded

on the basis of Union County's strong record of effective programs that help people get back on their feet. So on behalf of the Freeholder Board I would like to thank Frank Guzzo, Director of the Department of Human Services, and all of the community organizations that worked diligently to ensure that Union County residents benefit from these federal funds.

Freeholder Wright thanked Nicole DiRado for her help during these past few weeks, and stated that she is looking forward to working with the new Clerk, Jim Pellettiere. She thanked the Board for their help during her transition, and said she is looking forward to making a difference.

Freeholder Estrada commended Nicole DiRado for her years of service and wished her well. He said he is looking forward to working with the new Clerk, Jim Pellettiere.

Freeholder Estrada stated that he was appointed to the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority Committee. He commended Freeholder Sullivan who was the Chairman of the Committee. He respects him tremendously for his involvement in the past making sure Union County received their share of funding.

Freeholder Estrada wished Freeholder Wright luck and extended his congratulations.

County Counsel Barry wished Nicole DiRado the best, and said that they will continue to have interactions with their offices.

County Manager Faella commended Director Guzzo and his staff with work on the Code Blue program. He congratulated Nicole.

Freeholder Carter thanked Nicole for her work as Clerk. She said she made her transition to the Board very smooth. She said the County is lucky to continue using her experience and knowledge as the Deputy County Clerk.

Chairman Mirabella said it is nice to start off the year with an exchange of commendations and suggestions from the public and the Board. He said so far, it has been done respectfully.

Chairman Mirabella thanked the Council of Summit for attending and staying for the entire meeting.

Chairman Mirabella stated that there is a new program coming up. It is a yearlong series of networking sessions called Union County Means Business, and it is designed especially for business owners and managers in Union County, and for anyone who is planning to do business in Union County. He said we are bringing you together, in one room, with officials from state and local agencies that can help you connect with the resources you need to succeed. That includes services like employee recruitment through our One-Stop Centers, training and educational opportunities, social media guidance, and information about grants, loans and other programs. He said to underscore how important this program is, Senators Lesniak and Kean are attending our kickoff session next Wednesday, February 1. For information on sessions throughout the year or for any questions about Union County Means Business, he urged the public to visit our website at ucnj.org or to call the County Manager's office, 908-527-4200. Chairman Mirabella thanked Amy Wagner, Bureau Chief of Government Relations and Community Outreach and Cherron Rountree, Deputy Director of Parks and Community Renewal.

Chairman Mirabella spoke about a fire on South Avenue in Westfield. He is pleased with the teamwork associated with mutual aid. He said 12 towns responded to the fire, and he was happy to

announce that there were no fatalities. He congratulated all the firefighters involved.
