ORDINANCE FOR INTRODUCTION

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND "THE LAWS OF UNION COUNTY: 764-2015 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AND **POLICIES** AND **GENERAL** LEGISLATION" BY AMENDING PART 1, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE XVI-DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN **SERVICES**; ARTICLE DEPARTMENT OF RUNNELLS SPECIALIZED HOSPITAL; ARTICLE XIX DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND **FACILITIES** MANAGEMENT; ARTICLE XXIV, DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AND, PART 2, CHAPTER 100, PERSONNEL.

FIRST READING STATEMENT

Vice Chairman Bergen, Policy Chairman, will move Ordinance Number 764-2015 for First Reading and authorizing the Clerk of the Board to advertise same in accordance with the law. The Final Reading and Public Hearings are scheduled for May 14, 2015.
