Authorizing the County Manager to award the proposed contract obtained through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A:11-1 et seq: Department of Administrative Services, Division of Motor Vehicle, Hertrich Fleet Services, Milford, Delaware for the purpose of providing One (1) 2016 Ford Explorer SUV, for a total amount not to exceed \$39,389. - 2. Authorizing the County Manager to award a contract to Eric M. Bernstein, & Association, LLC, Warren, New Jersey to serve as labor and personnel counsel from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00. (Chairman Mohamed S. Jalloh)

Deputy County Manager/Director Reyes stated he has an additional resolution authorizing the County to partner with United Way of Union County to focus on family issues to establish two new family success centers in the County.

Chairman Jalloh asked Deputy County Manager/Director Reyes to provide the Board with backup before the Regular Meeting next week.

- 1. Authorizing the County Manager to approve the 2015 2019 Five (5) Year Consolidated Action Plan and the 2015 2016 (Year 41) Annual Consolidated Action Plan including the Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnerships Program, and the Emergency Solutions Grants Program application for HUD Funds. (Chairman Mohamed S. Jalloh)
- 2. Authorizing the County Manager to enter into an agreement with T&M Associates, Middletown, New Jersey, an Environmental Engineering Services firm selected through an Request for Proposal process, in an amount not to exceed \$600,000.00 to complete tasks outlined in the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Brownfield Assessment Grant awarded to the County as stated in Resolution 2014-856 and to be completed by September 2017. (Chairman Mohamed S. Jalloh)
- 3. Authorizing the County Manager to award a Professional Engineering Service Contract to T&M Associates, Middletown, New Jersey to provide LSRP services to review the existing public documentation and prepare a plan to resume the site remediation activities for the former Venneri Site located at 300 North Avenue, Westfield, New Jersey at no cost to the County. The former Licensed Site Remediation Professional (LSRP) for this contract is employed by T&M Associates. (Union County Project Number 2011-031) (Chairman Mohamed S. Jalloh)

Authorizing the County Manager to award subcontracts under the FY2016 Social Services for the Homeless (SSH) Spending Plan in the total amount not to exceed \$343,298 for subcontracted services to be provided during the period of July 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015, further authorizing the transfer of funds among the awarded agencies during the contract period should service needs change and/or if any fails to meet its contractual obligation, and further authorizing a one-time advance payment of up to one month of the award amount to prevent undue hardship for the agencies to carry out the program activities. - 2. Authorizing the County Manager to award subcontracts, pursuant to a Request For Proposals (RFP) procurement process, for a portion of the funding under the 2015 Alcohol/Drug Abuse Grant for the period of June 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 in the total amount not to exceed \$71,421 and further authorizing the transfer of funds among the awarded agencies during the contract period should service needs change and/or if any of the agencies fails to meet its contractual obligation. (Freeholder Bette Jane Kowalski)

- 3. Amending Resolution Number 2014-1041, adopting the 2015 State Respite Care Spending Plan, to formally change the alternate name of one agency from YMCA of Eastern Union County to The Gateway Family YMCA. (Freeholder Bette Jane Kowalski)
- 4. Amending Resolution Number 2015-1.13, adopting the 2015 Area Plan Contract Spending Plan, to formally change the alternate name of one agency from YMCA of Eastern Union County to The Gateway Family YMCA. (Freeholder Bette Jane Kowalski)
- 5. Amending Resolution Number 2014-475, to reflect an increase to the 2015 Municipal Alliance Plan countywide subcontract with Prevention Links, Inc., Roselle, New Jersey, in the amount of \$1,000 for a new subcontract total amount of \$7,000; and a decrease to the Countywide Activities in the amount of \$1,000 resulting in a change in line items only and no change in total dollars to the 2015 Alliance Plan nor in the grant extension period of July, 2014 through June 30, 2015. Director Guzzo replied yes, the County has received dollars in the past for this program.

Freeholder Hudak asked about the program.

Director Guzzo stated that it is for a countywide heroin addiction program.

Authorizing the County Manager to award the proposed contract obtained through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A:11-1 et seq: Department of Public Works and Facilities Management, to Ennis Paint, Inc., Thomasville, North Carolina, for the purpose of providing traffic paint for a contract period of twenty-four months in the amount of \$43,060. He stated that as per the NJ State Statute 48A:4-9C the amendments are such that it states that a public hearing on the amendments is not necessary or required. It does not add a new item of appropriation in the amount in excess of 1% of the total amount of appropriations as stated in the approved budget or increase or decrease any item of appropriation by more than 10% or increase the amount to be raised by taxes by more than 5%, unless the same is made to include an emergency temporary appropriation only.

Freeholder Carter stated she would have a laudatory resolution for the next meeting.

Vice Chairman Bergen stated he would have a laudatory resolution for the next meeting.

Chairman Jalloh stated he would have additional Advisory Board appointments.

- 1. Resolution determining that the 2015 Union County Budget shall be read by title and declaring that the public hearing conditions set forth pursuant to N.J.S.A.:4-8(1a)(1b) have been satisfied. (Chairman Mohamed S. Jalloh)
- 2. Appointing John Stewart to the Union County Transportation Advisory Board to represent the City of Plainfield for a term commencing January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. (Freeholder Sergio Granados)
- 3. Laudatory resolution recognizing National Police Week throughout Union County, and further commending the Union Township Valor Award recipients at the Annual Police Week Ceremony on May 14, 2015. (Chairman Mohamed S. Jalloh)

The minutes of the Executive Session, redacted as appropriate and necessary, shall be available in approximately 30 days. The Clerk of the Board shall retain the original minutes until such time as the confidential limitations have been removed, at which time they shall be made available. Upon the Board's return, it will not take formal action on the matters discussed as it is an Agenda setting meeting. Upon a majority vote of the members present, the Board may now retire to Executive Session.

On a motion made by Freeholder Carter and seconded by Freeholder Hudak, roll call showed five members of the Board voted in the affirmative with Freeholder Kowalski, Freeholder Granados, Freeholder Mirabella and Freeholder Wright absent.
