# OFFICE OF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS

There were no questions or comments from the Board.

1. Authorizing the County Manager to award a contract as an exception to bidding for proprietary software support to Dominion Voting Systems, Denver, Colorado, for the purposes of providing licensing, maintenance and support for the WinEDS voting system to conduct elections in an amount not to exceed \$25,000. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)

#### DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

1. A resolution renewing the Union County Commodity Resale System, ID 99016-UCCRS; offering cooperative purchasing opportunities for Union County municipalities to participate in the purchase of gasoline and diesel fuel. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)

Freeholder Kowalski inquired as to the number of Union County municipalities that participate in the cooperative.

Director Yuska advised that the smaller municipalities participate: Garwood, Kenilworth, Springfield and Winfield.

# **DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS**

There were no questions or comments from the Board.

1. Authorizing the County Manager to enter into an Inter-Governmental Agreement with the County of Essex Department of Corrections, Newark, New Jersey, to provide supervision and security for the inmates housed in the Secure Medical unit located in the East Orange General Hospital in accordance with the attached inter-local agreement. This agreement shall take effect March 1, 2017 and remain in effect for a two year period - ending February 28, 2019. (Chairman Bruce H. Bergen)

# DEPARTMENT OF ENGINEERING, PUBLIC WORKS & FACILITIES MANAGEMENT

Joseph Graziano, Director

Relative to Agenda Item #9, Director Graziano advised that the County opened the Bid earlier in the day and advised that the bid price was in the amount of \$295,400 and would be awarded to Simplicity Engineering (low bidder). He advised that this would provide the leaf compost equipment needed by the County to take on the operations of the Hudaille Quarry.

- 1. Authorizing the County Manager to enter into a Shared Service Agreement between the County of Union and the City of Elizabeth for design and installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of Jefferson Avenue (County Route 637) and North Avenue (a City Roadway), City of Elizabeth, New Jersey. (Freeholder Linda Carter)
- 2. Awarding a Professional Engineering Service Contract to T&M Associates of Middletown, New Jersey to provide ongoing LSRP Environmental Consulting Services associated with the Meisel Park Project, Springfield, for an amount not to exceed \$49,600.00. (NJDEP Case 99-04-28-1512 and 01-08-29-1446-05; NJDEP Program Interest ID#130838; Union County Engineering Project #2011-030) (Freeholder Linda Carter)
- 3. Amending Resolution Number 2016-112, a Professional Engineering Service Contract with Remington & Vernick & Arango, of Haddonfield, New Jersey to provide additional Licensed Site Remediation Professional (LSRP) services related to the Zimmerman Park located in Union, New Jersey in an amount not to exceed \$4,000.00 for a new contract amount not to exceed \$28,005.00. (Union County Engineering Project Number 2013-008) (Freeholder Linda Carter)
- 4. Authorizing the County Manager to award a Professional Engineering Service Contract, through a Request for Proposal (RFP) process, to Alaimo Group Consulting Engineers, of Mt. Holly, New Jersey to provide Design, Construction Administration and Inspection Services for the Emergency Generator Department of Public Works (DPW) Facility, Scotch Plains, New Jersey for an amount not to exceed \$85,420.00. (Union County Engineering Project Number 2013-028) (Freeholder Linda Carter)

- 5. Authorizing the County Manager to award a Professional Engineering Service Contract, through a Request for Proposal (RFP) process, to Maser Consulting, PA, of Red Bank, New Jersey to provide Engineering Design Services for Dam Repair Improvements for an amount not to exceed \$82,108.00. (Union County Engineering Project Number 2016-043) (Freeholder Linda Carter)
- 6. Authorizing the County Manager to award a Professional Engineering Service Contract, through a Request for Proposal (RFP) process, to Mott MacDonald, of Morristown, New Jersey to provide Engineering Services for the Lenape Park Dam Rehabilitation for an amount not to exceed \$46,000.00. (Union County Engineering Project Number 2016-044) (Freeholder Linda Carter)
- 7. Amending Resolution Number 2016-692, (BA#44-2014) a contract awarded through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A:11-1 et seq., to National Fence Systems, Inc., Avenel, New Jersey approving Change Order Number One (1) increasing the original contract amount by \$85,000 for a new total contract amount not to exceed \$324,003.98. (Freeholder Linda Carter)

Vice Chairman Granados inquired as to the reason for the increase.

Director Graziano advised the Board of some safety concerns at the Quarry; noting that trees have been falling along the fence line on Shunpike Road's quarry gates. He stated that this work is to be added to the current contract. He also noted that, recently, the State Police were hovering (helicopter) over the property line in search for a missing persons case. He added that the County has purchased expensive equipment to operate the facility (noting his Agenda Item #9) and this work would add to the safety and security of the property.

- 8. Authorizing the County Manager to award the proposed contract extension originally obtained through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A:11-1 et seq: Department of Engineering, Public Work & Facilities, Division of Facilities Management, Core Mechanical, Inc., Pennsauken, New Jersey, for the purpose of providing Pipefitting & Heating Systems Service Repair, Maintenance and Installation, twenty-four (24) consecutive months, in an amount not exceed \$296,400.00. (Freeholder Linda Carter)
- 9. Authorizing the County Manager to award the proposed contract obtained through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A:11-1 et seq: Department of Engineering, Public Works & Facilities Management, (TO BE DETERMINED), for the purpose of providing a Hydraulic Mobile Trommel Screen in the amount of (TO BE DETERMINED) (Freeholder Linda Carter)

Freeholder Mirabella asked if County Counsel has reviewed the specs and the bids from the opening.

Director Graziano advised the Board that County Counsel did review the specifications, and that with Robert Barry's assistance, the bid has been reviewed by County Counsel and Purchasing.

10. Authorizing the County Manager to award the proposed contract obtained through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A:11-1 et seq: Department of Engineering, Public Works & Facilities Management; and Department of Parks & Recreation, to Weldon Materials, Westfield, NJ, for the purpose of

providing Road Materials for an extended twelve month (12) contract an amount not to exceed \$628,191.75. (Freeholder Linda Carter)

- 11. Resolution ratifying permission granted to the Township of Scotch Plains to place a banner across Park Avenue, February 6, 2017 through February 27, 2017 to advertised the Trinitas Regional Medical Center Health and Wellness Expo hosted by the Greater Westfield Area Chamber of Commerce which is scheduled for February 26, 2017 at Snuffy's Pantagis in Scotch Plains. (Freeholder Linda Carter)
- 12. Resolution concurring with the Township of Berkeley Heights granting permission to the Brooke Healy Foundation to hang a banner from May 29, 2017 through June 12, 2017 on Plainfield Avenue for the Brooke Healey Foundation Bikers for Brook Healey Motorcycle Run and Family Barbeque. (Freeholder Linda Carter)

# **DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES**

- 1. Authorizing the County Manager to accept 2016 SuperNOFA Continuum of Care (CoC) competitive grant award funds in the total amount not to exceed \$4,598,725 from US Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) and to award subcontracts with varied one-year time frames as specified on the Spending Plan; further authorizing the transfer of funds among the awarded agencies during the contract period should service needs change and/or if any fails to meet its contractual obligation; and further authorizing a one-time advance payment of up to one month of the award amount to prevent undue hardship for the agencies to carry out the program activities. - 2. Authorizing the County Manager to award an amount not to exceed \$99,451 to Prevention Links Inc., Roselle, New Jersey, for the grant period January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 as an approved allocation from the Juvenile Justice Commission to provide program services based on the Juvenile Justice Commission Points of Continuum: Detention and Disposition. services in the total amount not to exceed \$132,000; and a concession fee to the County of Union of five (5%) percent for the first year (10 months); and seven (7%) percent for the 2nd year of the gross revenue from the Pro Shop and all of food and beverage sales. (Vice Chairman Sergio Granados)

2. Authorizing the County Manager to award the proposed contract obtained through advertised public bidding in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A:11-1 et seq: Department of Parks & Recreation, Division of Engineering, Pavelec Brothers Golf Course Construction, Inc., of Nutley, New Jersey, for the Sensory Trail Improvements Watchung Reservation, Borough of Mountainside, County of Union, New Jersey, for an amount not to exceed \$652,442.85. (Union County Engineering Project Number 2016-006) (Vice Chairman Sergio Granados)
