Covenant House New Jersey's Union Rapid Rehousing Rental Assistance Project seeks to provide permanent housing in the form of tenant based RRH rental assistance to homeless youth between 18 and 22 years old and their babies in Union County. The project will create 6 new units of housing, with 2 beds per

unit (one for the parent, one for the child) and will ensure that the County's young parents have a safe and stable place to nurture and parent their babies. The goals of the program are twofold: (1) to house youth in permanent scattered site housing across the County and (2) to ensure that they remain stably housed by providing wrap-around services designed to equip them with the skills, habits and attitudes necessary to sustain permanent independent living. Our staff will work with the young person to identify appropriate and affordable housing, connect them with mainstream resources and will provide on-going case management to ensure that they successfully break the cycle of homelessness, not just for them, but also for their children.
