PUBLIC NOTICE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS Notice is hereby given that the Union County Workforce Development Board ("WDB") will receive proposals on Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at 11:00 a.m., EDT. in the Union County Administration Building, Small Conference Room, 4th Floor, 10 Elizabethtown Plaza, Elizabeth, NJ, for the provision of: WORKFORCE INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT AMERICAN JOB CENTER AFFILIATE CAREER SERVICES OPERATOR The funding source is Program Year 2018/2019 Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act funds. The anticipated funding period is July 1, 2019- December 31, 2020. Proposals are being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4. The Union County Workforce Development Board (WDB), in accordance with Section 107 of the Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act of 2014, is charged with developing effective strategies to train individuals in demand occupations. This Request for Proposals is soliciting proposals to procure a single service provider of an American Job Center Affiliate Career Services Operator under the provisions of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act. The Board is seeking interested and qualified entities able to provide innovative, high quality services to adult and dislocated workers. Services provided under this RFP are targeted to preserve and create jobs, prepare workers for employment, and to assist employers with their training needs to support economic expansion. Funding allocations governed by this public notice will be included in the Request for Proposals. Successful Proposers must demonstrate current or future service delivery capabilities to serve adults in Union County effectively. Proposals must be made in the form required by the RFP specifications and one (1) original, two (2) copies, and 1 (one) PDF electronic copy on a CD or Thumb Drive must be received no later than 11:00 a.m. (EDT) on Wednesday, May 22, 2019.
