RESOLUTIONS FOR ADOPTION

The following resolutions are being offered for adoption:

- **2024-243 COMMISSIONER JAMES BAKER JR:** Authorizing the County Manager to enter into a five (5) year lease agreement with Wireless Edge Towers II, LLC for radio antennas, equipment shelter, and stand-by generator effective May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2029 in the amount of \$14,400.00 for the first year with a 3% increase each subsequent year.
