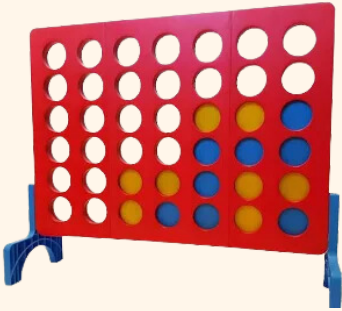
**Welcome
